Support for scientific dissemination by student members of the ESVO in veterinary ophthalmology

Purpose

The European Society of Veterinary Ophthalmology offers financial support in order to contribute to the dissemination of scientific knowledge and information in the field of veterinary ophthalmology. This support consists of the reimbursement of registration fees, lodging and travel expenses for students, member of the ESVO, presenting the results of their work (orally or in poster format) at an ESVO scientific meeting.

Value and Tenure

The maximum amount is 750€ / year for one student per laboratory. In 2017, the maximum number of awards is for 2 students.

Eligibility

ESVO travel grant is open to Students in MSc and PhD studies or Residents. The applicant must be a member of the ESVO. Students who receive additional financial support from an official organization or a foundation which covers meeting fees are not eligible. Priority will be given to students not currently holding grants. However, students currently holding grants but who are not yet receiving funds are eligible.

Administration

The ESVO travel grant scheme is administered by the ESVO.

Application procedure

Students must personally present their work (orally or by poster) at an ESVO scientific meeting and should have contributed significantly to the presented study. The applicant must be first author of the study to be eligible. Completed applications (see below) must be received until 15th July 2017 for the 2017 ESVO Meeting. The application form must be downloaded from the ESVO website and sent by mail (see information in the application form). Acceptable expenses are: registration fees, transport, living expenses (lodging, meals). Original boarding passes and receipts should be provided in order to obtain the reimbursement.

Finance

Payment of the ESVO grant will not be made without proof. Receipts of purchase are required (see above). Payment will be made to the grant-holder, exclusively.

Withdrawal of ESVO grants

ESVO reserves the right at any time and without notice to withdraw a grant either in full or in part, if the grant-holder fails to comply with the above regulations.

Acceptance

The signature of the applicant on the application signifies acceptance of these regulations.
